REPORT ON EK MUTTHI DHANYA

With the blessings from Mother Nature, as per planned schedule, the “EK MUTTHI DHANYA” event was organised on 06th & 07-May-2017. The event was upheld with the collaboration of NSS unit as well as the Rotary Club. The event was scheduled in three stages; the first one being the awareness among the Society, second being the collection of the Dhanya and the third one was to distribute the collection to the needy people.



The Rotary Club took initiative to aware the people by giving the press note in newspaper regarding the the Joy of Giving. The second stage activity was carried by creating different teams which consists of one Rotary Club Member (Hardik Patel and Dhaval Shah) etc one NSS Member (Prof. Vyom Pathak, Prof. Hitesh Tailor, Prof. Hiren Rathod, Prof. Dhaval Jadhav & Prof. Harshal Shukla) and 3 NSS Volunteers, and hence total team formed was 12 which covered the whole Bardoli town.

The team formed was given a particular area and society of town in order to get maximum collection of cereals. With the collective efforts of all, collection reach to a highest bar from last year, i.e. total collection was around 5060kg. The following table shows the descriptive collection data:

Third stage activity was to distribute the cereals collected to the Dethli Village (Village which was adopted by the Rotary Club in conjunction with NSS from SNPIT & RC in order to improve the village in all dimensions of life). The activity was completed on 14th may 2017, where in the NSS volunteers participated actively and gave the cereals equally to each and every home.
