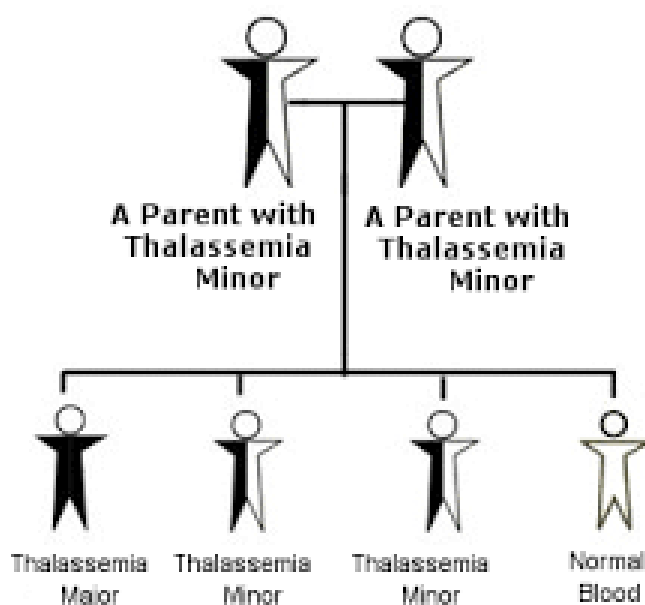

REPORT ON THALASSEMIA TESTING - (2017-2018)

A special camp was organized at SNPIT & RC, Umrakh (049) on 20th November 2017 (Monday) for Thalassemia Test of all the First Semester of Undergraduate as well as Post Graduate students of the college. The Indian Red-Cross Society—Ahmedabad was specially invited for collection of blood samples for testing 373 All First Semester students of Undergraduate as well as Post Graduate students were made aware about Thalassemia, its type and the effect of this blood—disorder in our life.



The importance of Thalassemia testing was also elaborated as it is the only measure of preventing spreading of this disorder. An informative documentary was also shown to the students on the day before the testing and during the camp. Counseling was provided by the senior faculties regarding the awareness related to their health issues and particularly about the importance of Thalassemia in the blood. A large number of students were present during the camp for getting their blood tested. It is noteworthy international students admitted to institute during this year 2017 have also participated in this event and appreciated instituted and university for this awareness.

Total 373 students of various branches of First semester given their blood samples for testing. The whole event was well organized and controlled by the NSS Team with Class-Co-ordinator of each department.
