

REPORT ON TRAFFIC AWARENESS

12th April, 2017

A traffic awareness program was organised by SNPIT & RC, under the NSS Activity on Tuesday (11th April 2017) in which the **Asst. Sub-Inspector "Mr. Rajasinh V. Patel"** was the Chief Incharge handling his unit at UTU Circle near linear bus stand. Around 40 NSS Volunteers and 4 NSS Committee members (Prof. Hitesh Tailor, Prof. Dhaval Jadhav, Prof. Denish Prajapati and Prof. Harshal Shukla) actively participated in the Traffic Awareness Program.

The Chief explained various traffic rules and traffic signals to NSS Volunteers as well as the NSS Committee member and asked them to strictly observe the same also to aware the people. He addressed about the detailed information of various Dos and Don'ts, stressed upon the drivers to avoid dangerous driving, driving a two wheeler without helmet, using mobile while driving, driving after drinks, driving without license and so on asserting that majority of accidents are due to negligence on the part of vehicle operator.



After the short term training program, the Volunteers and NSS Committee member started distributing the Roses as a positive essence for awareness. Volunteers while distributing the roses conveyed the people said that it is the responsibility of the concerned department to control and manage the traffic, at the same time people should also cooperate so that the accidents are minimised.
